Subject: Justice at COP28

- ***Delivers the £11.6bn of international climate finance pledged at COP27*** to support vulnerable countries to the climate emergency over the 5-year period.
- ***Ensures a Loss and Damage Finance Facility is established at COP28, accessible to all countries*** and generously funded.
- ***Make sure that the EU Sustainable Food Systems Law is ready by the end of the current Commission's mandate*** to demonstrate at COP28 our commitment to fully implementing the EU Green Deal.
- ***Prioritises a fast and fair transition to renewable energy***, including the end of all new fossil fuel projects.

We must act now to protect our planet and those most vulnerable to climate change.
