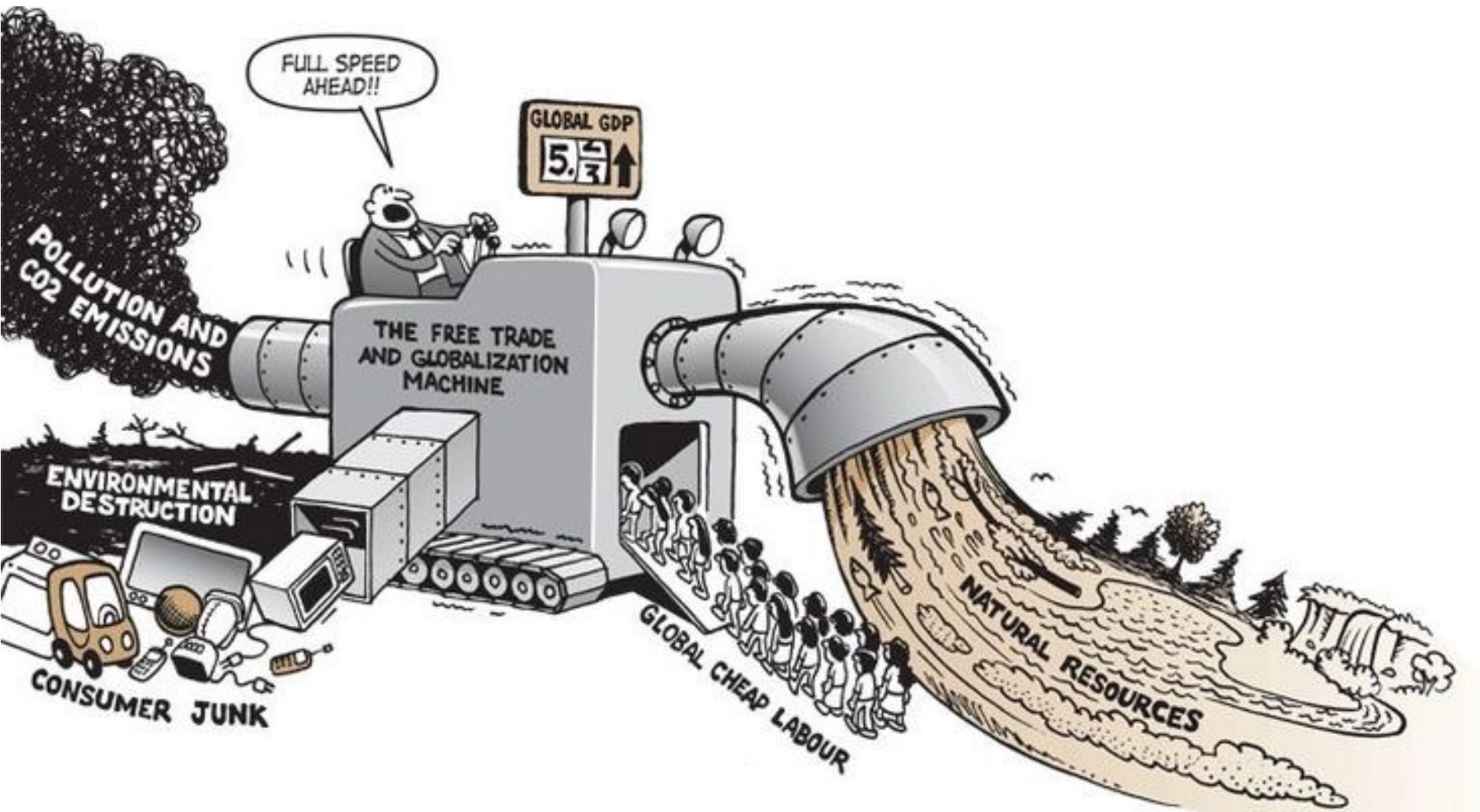

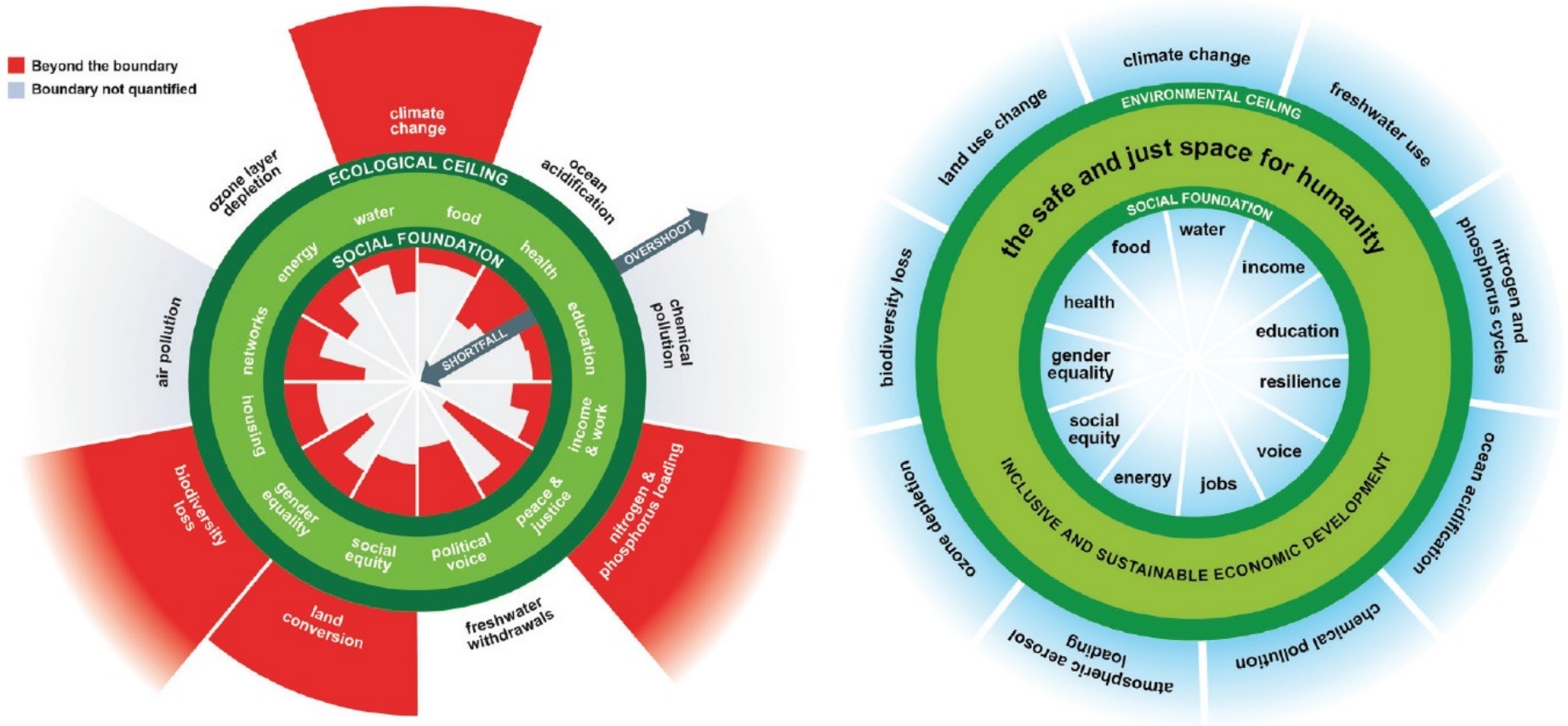
- 6 countries in **Africa**, 5 in **Latin America** + **Israël/Palestine**

- +/- 2.000 volunteers in **Belgium** linked to parishes in 5 provinces in Flanders



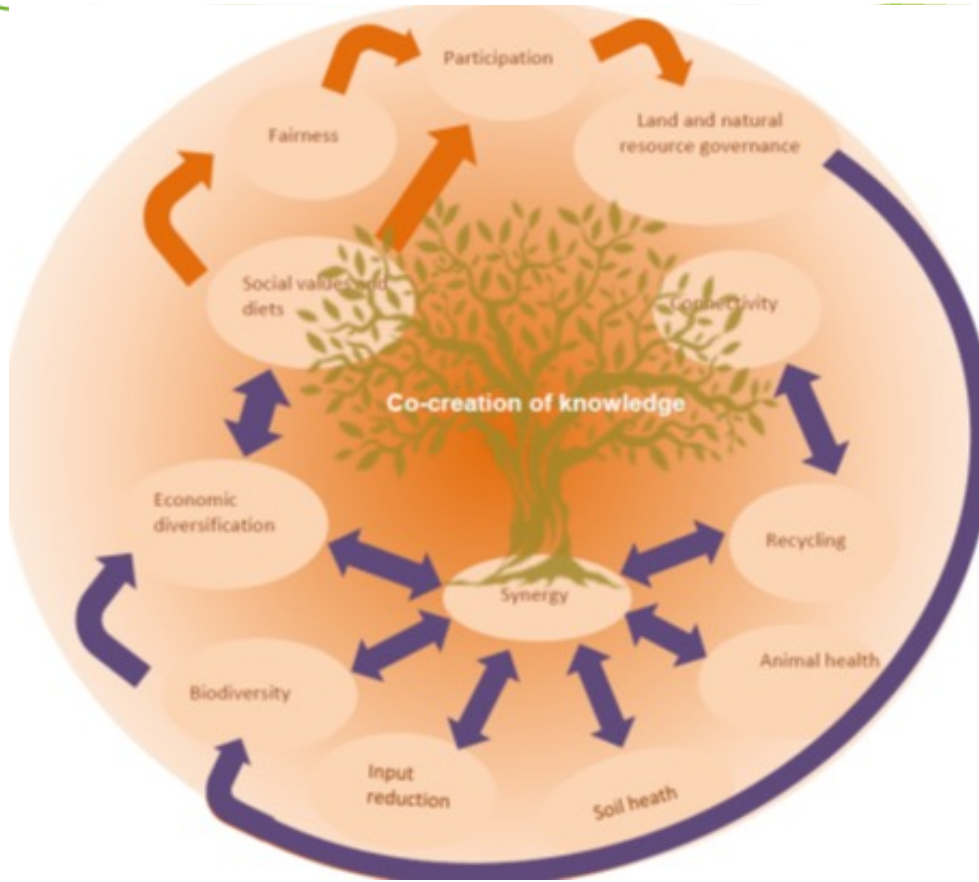

### WE USE FIVE STRATEGIES

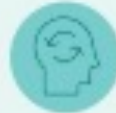
To achieve change in these three areas, we adopt these strategies:
